

CYC Single Handed Race July 31

NOTICE OF RACE

INVITATION: The Corinthian Yacht Club invites all eligible boats to participate in the CYC Single-Handed Race, to be held on the Columbia River between the I-5 and I-205 bridges.

DESCRIPTION: A one-race event open to boats with only one individual (skipper) on board.

ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS: Each entering skipper must be a member of a PIYA recognized yacht club or a member of the Oregon Corinthian Sailing Association. Each entering boat must have a current PHRF certificate unless sailing level or one design. All boats without a current PHRF certificate will not be scored. The current International Sailing Federation Racing Rules of Sailing with the prescriptions of US Sailing, current OCSA Sailing Instructions, applicable level or one design rules, and any supplemental sailing instructions will govern these races. Steering devices will be allowed.

DATE AND TIME: July 31. Warning signal at 1500 hours. If it is not possible to complete a race on July 31, the race will be rescheduled for Sunday, August 1 at 1500 hours.

REGISTRATION: Boats must pre-register for this race no later than 72 hours prior to the start. Use an OCSA Race Entry Form and mail with fee to:

FEES: \$30 for members of a PIYA recognized yacht club, \$40 for all others. Skippers must notify the CYC Race Captain of their intention to enter the race by 72 hours prior to the race. Please make check payable to CYC. CYC racing members need not pay an entry fee but MUST register, late registration \$35 for members of a PIYA recognized club (including CYC members), \$45 for all others.

SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

CLASS DIVISIONS: Class divisions will be posted on the committee boat or provided in a handout.

COURSES: Courses from the 2010 OCSA Course Charts or courses set by the Committee will be posted on the committee boat. The committee boat may have a separate start and finish line.

SCORING: Boats withdrawing from a race must notify the Race Committee to avoid disqualification. Four or more registrations will constitute a class fleet. Three or more boats must start for one design or level fleets to validate the race for that fleet. Fleets wishing to race one design or level must so indicate on their application. All races will be scored.

TROPHIES: The number of prizes awarded will be based on the number of boats registered by the time limit. Awards will be held on Sunday, Oct. 3 after the CYC Fall Regatta. 3 boats = 1 Prize; 5 boats = 2 Prizes; 12 boats = 4 Prizes

PROTEST: A boat intending to protest must notify the Race Committee on-the-water prior to the Race Committee leaving station. A written protest form must be received by noon the following day by Eric Rouzee at fax number 503-289-7444 or by email to Eric at erouzee@gmail.com.

COMMUNICATIONS: Additional supplemental sailing instructions may be available from committee boat. Results will be posted on sailpdx.com.
