NOTICE OF RACE

INVITATION: SYSCO and Columbia Crossings invite all boat skippers of one design, level and cruising class fleets to compete on the Columbia River. The regatta will be a benefit for Columbia Riverkeepers.

DESCRIPTION: This is a one day regatta with two or more races planned.

ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS: A minimum of three boats will be required to constitute a level fleet or one design class. PHRF ratings are not required. Current designations of level fleets and one design subclasses are found on the SYSCO Fleet List contained in this book. Races shall be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules Of Sailing including the national prescriptions of US Sailing, as modified by the OCSA Sailing Instructions, applicable level or one design rules, and the supplemental instructions of this notice.

DATES AND TIMES: Saturday, August 14, first warning signal at 1300 hours. When more than one race is scheduled to be held on the same day, racers should remain in the vicinity of the Race Committee after all boats in their class have finished, to receive additional signals from the Race Committee. Start sequence for the finished fleet may begin shortly after last boat finishes.

REGISTRATION: Use the OCSA Race Entry Form and mail with your fee to:

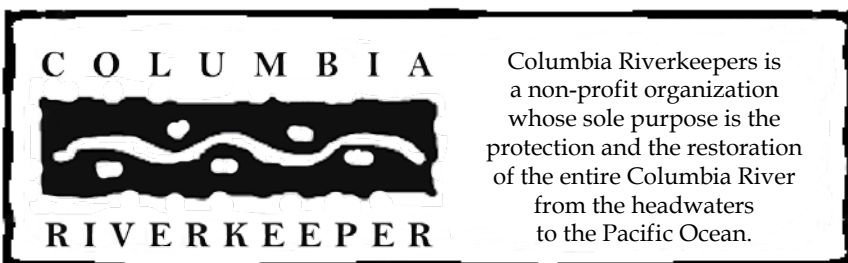

Entry forms for registration not requiring a fee may be faxed to SYSCO Race Captain at 503-598-7063 or emailed to syccosail@gmail.com. One-design entrants are expected to confirm a sufficient number of boats to form a fleet or class before entry. A \$10.00 late fee must accompany entries received after 72 hours before the start of the race. No entries will be accepted after 2100 hours Friday before the race.

FEES: \$30 for PIYA affiliated club members, \$35 for all others. Make checks payable to SYSCO. Entry fees are not required of SYSCO members; however, SYSCO members must register, and are subject to the late entry fee provisions.

SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

CLASS DIVISIONS: The Race Committee will display level fleets and one design subclasses as consistent with the SYSCO Fleet list and entries received.

COURSES: Courses from the 2010 OCSA Course Charts or courses set by the Race Committee will be posted on the committee boat.

SCORING: All races will be scored. One completed race shall constitute a series. The Low Point Scoring System of the Racing Rules of Sailing shall apply.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded following the last race at the Columbia Crossings Social. Trophies will be awarded based on the number of boats registered 72 hours prior to the start of the regatta, and as follows:

3 boats - 1 trophy

5 boats - 2 trophies

8 boats - 3 trophies

11 boats - 4 trophies

Classes having fewer than 3 starting boats will not receive trophies. An overall Columbia Crossings Cup will be awarded to the best performing boat.

PROTESTS: The protesting boat must indicate their intention to protest to the Race Committee at the end of the race. Protests must meet the requirements of the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (protest form preferred but not required) and be delivered to the Race Committee, or faxed to 503-907-5507, or emailed to alden642@comcast.net within two hours after completion of the last race.

COMMUNICATIONS: Race results will be posted at www.sailpdx.com.
